












#### Fun-Fabulous-Fabric-Folded Star

# Brown Sugar Loaf By: El's Kitchen



#### **INGREDIENTS**

- 1/2 cup butter softened
- 2 cups dark brown sugar
- 3 eggs
- 22/3 cups flour
- 1 cup milk
- 3 tsp. baking powder
- 1 tsp. cinnamon
- 1/2 tsp. cloves
- 1 tsp. vanilla
- 1 cup chopped walnuts

#### **DIRECTIONS**

- · Cream butter and sugar together
- · Add eggs and beat well.
- · Sift dry ingredients together and add milk.
- Stir in vanilla and nuts.
- Pour into greased loaf pan.
- Bake 1 hour in 350-degree oven.
- Serve with a slice of fresh, cold melon.

# Eleanor Burns Crockpot Cherry Cobbler By: El's Kitchen



#### **INGREDIENTS**

- 1 can (21 oz.) cherry pie filling
- 13/4 cup yellow cake mix (only half of box mix)
- 1/4 cup butter (1/2 stick), melted
- 2/3 cup chopped walnuts
- 2 tsp. vanilla

#### **DIRECTIONS**

- Spread cherry pie filling in bottom of crockpot.
- Mix cake mix, butter, and vanilla in bowl.
- Crumble cake mixture over cherries.
- Sprinkle with walnuts.
- Cover and cook on HIGH 2 hours or LOW 3-4 hours.

## 4-Ingredient Chocolate Cake Submitted By: Bethe Bryant



#### **INGREDIENTS**

- 1 box chocolate cake mix
- 1 small package instant chocolate pudding mix
- 2 cups semi-sweet chocolate chips
- · 2 cups 2% milk

#### **DIRECTIONS**

- Preheat oven to 350 degrees.
- · Grease 9x13 pan.
- Layer ingredients evenly:
  - Dry cake mix.
  - Dry chocolate pudding mix.
  - Top with 13/4 cup chocolate chips.
- Drizzle milk over top. Gently stir to combine everything.
- · Mix. Will look thick and lumpy.
- · Top with rest of chocolate chips.
- Bake until top looks set and edges pull away from dish 35-40 minutes.
- · Let cool slightly and serve warm.

#### **INGREDIENTS**

- 2 (9") deep dish pie crusts
- 1/2 stick unsalted butter
- 1 c. flaked coconut, toasted
- 1 c. pecans, roughly chopped
- 8 oz. cream cheese, softened
- 14 oz. can sweetened condensed milk
- 16 oz. Cool Whip
- 14 oz. caramel ice cream topping
- Makes 2 pies.

#### **DIRECTIONS**

- Preheat oven to 400 degrees. Bake pie shells according to package instructions. Let cool.
- In mixer, cream can of sweetened condensed milk & cream cheese. Gently fold in Cool Whip.
- In pan with butter, toast pecans and coconut. Allow to cool.
- To Fill Both Pie Shells:
  - 1/4 cream mix
  - 1/4 caramel
  - 1/4 cream mix
  - 1/2 coconut & pecans
- Freeze Repeat evenly between both pie shells.
- Thaw 15 minutes prior to serving.

Who: Active In-Stitches Members.

(Active members have first choice until April 1st. After April 1st, if there are vacant seats, registration will expand and be opened to the Contented Heart Quilt Guild members.

When: June 6, 2023

Cost \$25 per person (Your seat will not be held until your registration fee is paid.) Seating is limited! So, register today!!

NO refunds. If you cannot attend, it is your responsibility to find someone to take your place and they will pay you directly.

Meals will be on your own (Lunch & Dinner). Breakfast to go will be provided at the Wayne County Extension Office. Any shopping/ purchases you wish to make are on your own.

We will be leaving the Wayne County Extension Office at 6:30 am EST PROMPT! You must arrive at the Extension Office NO LATER than 6:15 am EST. Doors to the Extension Office will open at 6:00 am EST. There is mandatory sign in and Risk Management paperwork to fill out. Please make sure you have contact information ready for an emergency contact person. You will be given a schedule and more details for the day. We will be taking a charter bus with Miller Transportation.

Please dress for comfort as well as bring a sweater or jacket for inclement weather. Please wear Good SUPPORTIVE walking shoes. At the Quilt Show, a limited number of scooters will be available to rent, first come first serve. You are also welcome and encouraged to bring a tote with beverages/water and personal snacks. When we arrive, you will be on your own to explore the Quilt Show and Trade Show. We highly recommend the buddy system, or groups of two or more. You will be on your own for lunch.
